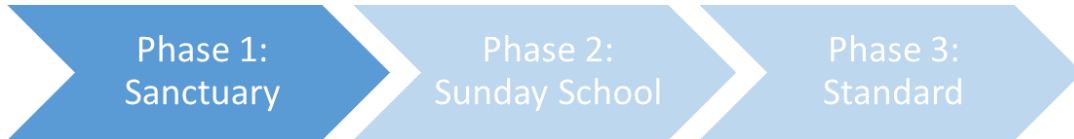
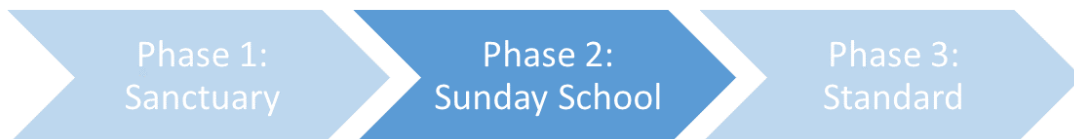


Our Plan Forward

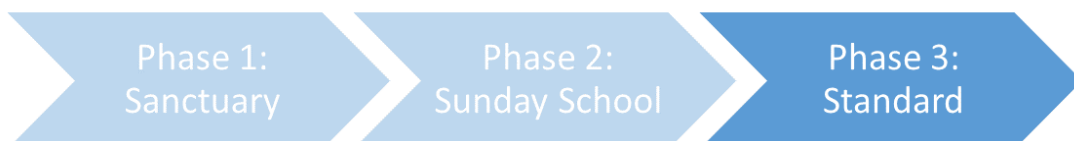
The goal of these rules are to keep everyone safe. This policy is an extension of protection and security policies that already exist. As always, the safety of our members and visitors is our primary concern at this time. Your safety is our concern and we ask that you make the safety of everyone around you be your priority. That's what you do when you love someone; you keep them safe. Love one another!



- Bethlehem Baptist Church will practice social distancing in the sanctuary on Sunday Mornings and Wednesday Nights.
- Before entry, your temperature will be taken using a temperature gun. If you have a fever or any symptoms that you believe are from COVID-19, please stay home.
- Upon entry, you will walk down the center aisle to a seat of your choosing. There are two seating areas on every other row. Large families may need to use the entire row.
- There will be no nursery or children's church.
- If you need to use restrooms or nursery prior to the start of service, please walk forward and then around the first row to the sides and walk back on the sides.
- If you need to use the nursery or restrooms after the start of service, use the nearest aisle to come in and out.
- We will allow only one person into either restroom at a time and a member of our security team will clean touched surfaces such as handles and seats using an anti-bacterial spray.
- There will be no bulletins, hymnals, pens, pencils or cards in the pews.
- Hand sanitizer will be located in the foyer and at connection corner.
- There will be no coffee or food served in connection corner.
- Offerings may be placed in the large metal bucket located in the foyer on your way in or out. Offerings may also be made on line at tithe.ly or directly from our church's website at bethlehemnewnan.com.
- During the invitation time, please pray in or directly beside your pew. If you need to speak to the pastor, please remain in the sanctuary until everyone else has left.
- You will be dismissed one row at a time by the ushers starting at the back of the church and moving forward so the first in will be the last out. As you exit, please practice social distancing in the parking lot.
- For those who choose to stay home, the service will be premiered on Facebook one week later when possible.



- Each class may discuss and present a plan to return that meets physical spacing requirements. Options may include alternative locations on or off campus, spaced seating.
- The plan must include room for children until such time as children's ministries resume.
- The plan must be approved by Adam Cain, Mark Toole, and Renee Walker.
- Classes with an approved plan can begin as early as August 2.
- Children's ministries must have adequate adult supervision to ensure distancing guidelines are met.



- The Executive Committee is committed to return all church functions to normal as soon as safely possible.
